



## Toi MAHARA Young Artists Exhibition 2024

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Submitting a work to the Toi MAHARA Young Artists Exhibition constitutes acceptance of these terms and conditions of entry:

#### Eligibility:

- (i) Artists and/or all members of artists group must be aged 13-25 years old at the time of entry.
- (ii) Entrant's main place of residence must be within the Council-defined regional boundaries of Kāpiti or Horowhenua, or they must have attended a Kāpiti or Horowhenua secondary school or wānanga.

#### Eligible work:

Original work in any medium, completed since September 2023 by an artist or group of artists living, working, or studying in the Kāpiti/Horowhenua region (as defined by Council boundaries). **Up to two** entries per artist/group may be submitted.

#### Acceptance of work:

- (i) Work should not have been shown elsewhere in the Kāpiti or Horowhenua region prior to this exhibition.
- (ii) Work must have been completed in the last year, between September 2023 and September 2024.
- (iii) Works should not exceed 2 metres in any direction or be heavier than 20kg.
- (iv) Work must not contain any unauthorised use of any copyright images, photographs, text or other material.
- (v) Entry will be by online form submission of up to two high quality photographs of each work being submitted, alongside the completed entry form.
- (vi) Notification: All entrants will be notified by email unless otherwise specified as to the outcome of the selection process. Notifications via e-mail will be sent out by Friday 18 October.
- (vii) Artists are responsible for delivery and collection of artwork that is accepted into the exhibition to the gallery, and for insurance during transit if necessary.
- (viii) Selected work for Toi MAHARA Young Artists Exhibition will remain on display for the duration of the exhibition.  
**Selection criteria:**
  - a. There is no theme or restriction on media, the selectors will select work based on its artistic merit and originality.
  - b. The decisions of the selectors are final, and no correspondence will be entered into.

**Deadline:**

Submissions must be received by **5pm, Monday 2 September 2024**. Late entries will not be accepted.

**Sale of Artworks:**

If your work is selected for the exhibition and you wish to have the work for sale, Toi MAHARA staff will advise you on the retail price.

If sold the gallery receives 38.33% (commission + GST) from the sale. It is not a requirement that your work will be for sale.

**Promotion:**

Toi MAHARA may use artists' names and photographs, and photographs of artworks for promotional purposes in any Toi MAHARA digital and printed publication or platform in perpetuity.
